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Find below some helpful information on how to make the most of the guide and itineraries.

You can add or exclude stops on the preprogrammed itinerary via Google Maps. The beginning and end points are always our office address in Corfu town. After loading the tour in Google Maps, you can change the tour start and end location by tapping the three dots icon (⋮) on the right side of the screen and adding your accommodation address or “my location”.

We have marked sights to add to the basic itinerary with the **+ plus symbol and red colour**. If you want to add any additional sights, you can tap the sight name to view the sight profile in Google Maps and load directions. We have placed the **‘+ plus’** locations in the ideal order during the preprogrammed itinerary stops. If you choose to **+ add** stops, please note that the non-stop driving time will last longer.

If you accidentally close the map during your tour, you can reload the route again, exclude the stops you have already visited, and continue navigating from your location! The routes are carefully planned; please remember that you may miss the initially planned route every time you adjust.

Please note that **hyperlinks are included in each location or establishment name and the "Tap Here" icons**. These links can help you find directions, view pictures, and read feedback from other travellers. However, please be careful when you click on a location name. It's best to zoom in and then select your preferred location to avoid confusion (choosing the wrong location).

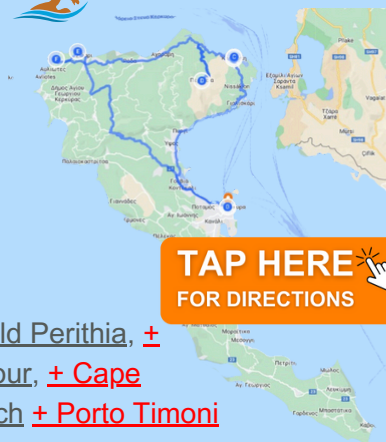

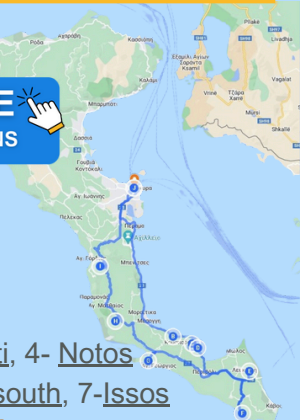

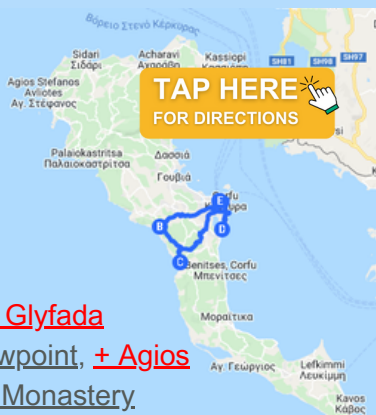

Useful Tips :

This tour itinerary is perfect for those who want to experience a slow ride in the rural areas of Corfu.

The route is relatively narrow, with many sharp turns (skilful scooter drivers).

⚠ Car drivers, please do not follow the scooter route!

If you are driving a small to medium car, we suggest you follow the alternative car-friendly itinerary, which is still a slow drive route.

This itinerary is **not** recommended for those who have not seen other parts of Corfu unless you seek an off-the-tourism-beaten-path experience.

When you visit a village, park somewhere safe, take a break and wander around the village alleys.

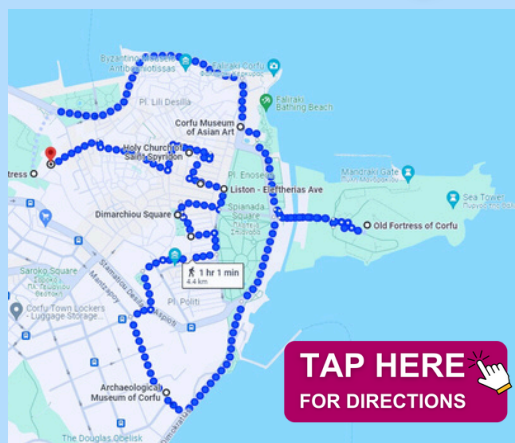
Useful Tips :

The entrance fee to the Danilla Village is 10€ per adult and 5€ per child. The amount may be used as a credit against consumption at "Kafeneion" only during the visit—James Bond's filming location "For Your Eyes Only" and the Durells TV series.

Achilleion Palace entrance fee: 5€ (You can visit only the garden they are renovating - restoring the interior) James Bond's filming location "For Your Eyes Only"

Entrance fee to the Mon Repo estate: Free entrance to wander the gardens and view the ancient temples. One of the filming locations of the Durells TV series.

4.8km - 2.7 miles

Main Sights: 1 New

Fortress, 2- Museum of Asian Art, 3-Old Fortress, 4-Archaeological Museum, + Windmill - Anemomilos 5- Dimarcheiou Square, 6- Liston, 7-Casa Parlante, 8- Saint Spyridon church, 9- Tenedos Church

While having a plan is helpful, remember to leave room for spontaneity. Follow your curious spirit and explore the alleys of the old city!



Useful Information:

The starting and ending locations of the walking route are near the old port and the New Fortress (it's easier to find a parking spot nearby, and it is also convenient for travellers coming and returning to the port). We have carefully created a circular route to ensure you will make the most of your walking route. We use some sights and landmarks for directions since the locations are very scenic. Whether you want to visit the museums or not is up to you. We highly recommend visiting the Old Fortress and the Archaeological Museum (if you have enough time + energy).

Entrance fee to the Old Fortress: 6€

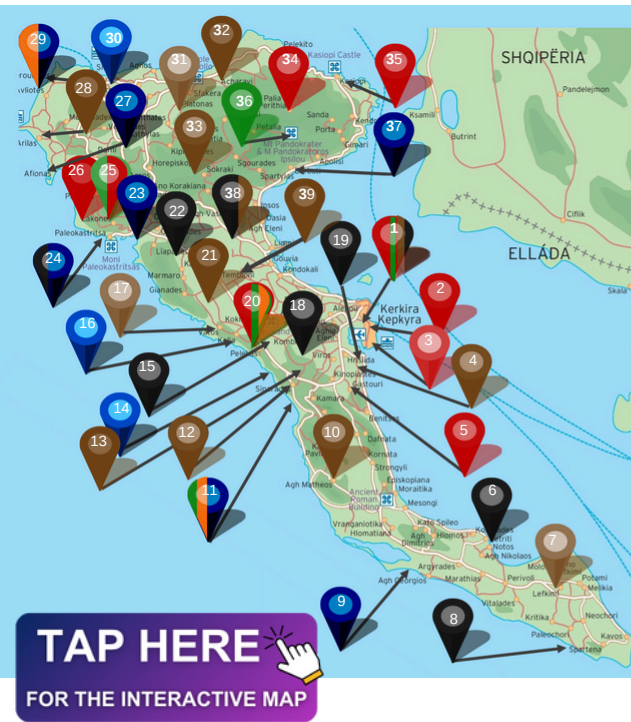
Entrance fee to the New Fortress: 4€

(valid for three days) for Museum of Palaiopolis-Mon Repos, Archaeological Museum of Kerkyra, Antivouniotissa Museum, Old Fortress, Museum of Asian Art

The ticket package can be purchased at the Old Fortresses Entrance ticket office or at the Archaeological Museum of Corfu ticket office.

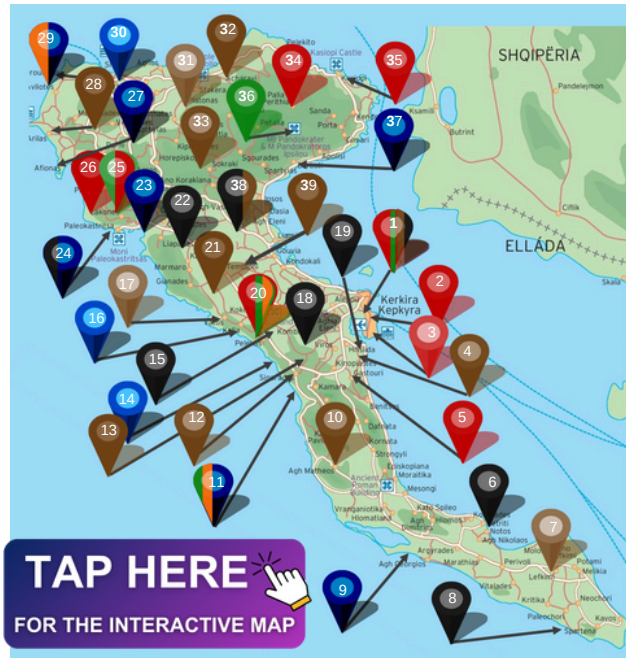

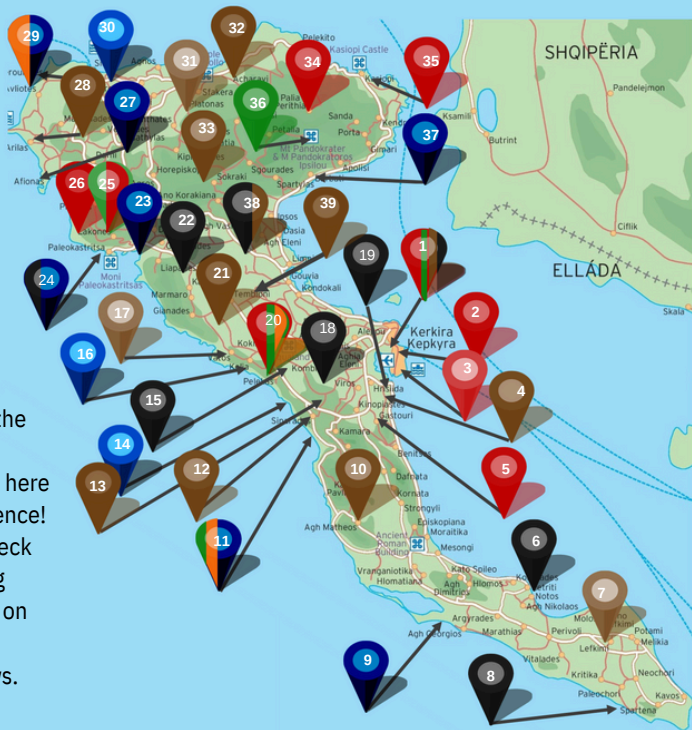

Must Taste Local Delicacies + Signature Flavors



SOFRITO: Finely sliced veal or beef cooked in a white wine + vinegar sauce with garlic, parsley and black pepper. [View more here!](#)



PASTITSADA: Meat cooked in a spicy tomato sauce. It has a rich taste because of the “Spetzeriko” spice mix! [View more here!](#)



BIANCO: Fish and potatoes cooked in a white wine sauce with loads of garlic, black pepper, and a drizzle of freshly squeezed lemon juice. [View more here!](#)



BOURDETO: Fish cooked in spicy wine sauce. Traditionally, it is spicy hot sauce. Some locals prefer to add tomato to the sauce, while others do not. The dish has a red-coloured sauce in both cases because of the ground paprika spice. [View more here!](#)



NERATZOSALATA: A spicy orange salad (ideally paired with a green leafy salad). [View more here!](#)



TSIGARELI: Wild greens cooked with spicy red hot paprika and tomato paste. [View more here!](#)



SIKOMAIDA: Sun-dried figs with hints of black pepper, anise, and grape must. [View more here!](#)
